Overview:

The CA LMI 2017 Summer Institute is a **two-day conference (June 20-21)** focused on labor management collaborative partnerships as a driver for improving teaching and learning, and meeting the needs of the whole child. Through a blend of content presentations, shared / cross-district learning, and district team activities and discussion, conference sessions will support district and county office teams to deepen their collaborative work. Session facilitators and presenters will include recognized leaders in the work, as well as practitioners who will share experiences and strategies that have helped them build partnerships in their schools and districts.

Prior to the Summer Institute will be a **one-day pre-conference (June 19)**. The pre-conference is intended for district and county office teams (and new team members from existing LMI districts) who are new to the theory and/or practice of labor management collaboration partnerships and their impact on both student learning and teacher retention in districts.
